


WITH SWINGING PENDULUM



The etched dial has gold ornamentation and a silver numeral circle. The hemispheres and the numbers are black. A set of highly polished ornamental chime rods and a swinging pendulum add further authenticity to this fine miniature. The pendulum bob is finished as spun brass with a polished pendulum rod.

The sturdy chiming mechanism is dependable and very simple in construction. The quarter hours are struck on four chime rods, and the hour chimes a chord of four rods. The longer chime rods in this clock produce a low resonant tone that is almost cathedral-like in quality. The hands may be turned forward or backward without incapacitating the chiming mechanism. The movement is equipped with a synchronous, self starting, low speed motor with the gears running in oil to insure silent and trouble free operation. It is constructed with the most advanced and approved methods of fine clock manufacture.


We are pleased to advise that for 1953 the prices for the Number 600 tambour and the Number 700 and 750 Avon clocks will remain the same.
