THE "REMELEC" SYSTEM OF TRUSTWORTHY AND SILENT ELECTRIC CLOCKS.

SUITABLE ALIKE FOR FACTORIES, HOTELS,
RAILWAYS, INSTITUTIONS, SCHOOLS,
OR RESIDENCES.

THE "REMELEC" SYSTEM consists of a "Master Pendulum" and any number of "Indicating Dials"—the PENDULUM makes an electrical connection each half minute, and each DIAL shows an advance of one half minute at each such connection.

The following points emphasise the great superiority of the "REMELEC" over any other Electrical Time - Indicating System.

CONCERNING THE PENDULUM:

- (i.) Accurate time-keeping.
- (ii.) Powerful, sparkless and trustworthy electrical contact.
- (iii) Silent action—there being no noise other than that of the regular "beat."
- (iv.) No winding.
- (v.) SIMPLICITY AND DURABILITY.

CONCERNING THE DIALS:

- (i.) Silent action—although all working parts are metal-to-metal and no perishable materials are used in the construction.
- (ii.) No "step-by-step" ratchet work. The hands being moved by the revolution of an electrically-operated iron disc or armature.
- (iii.) High efficiency without any delicate adjustments.

CONCERNING THE COMPLETE SYSTEM:

- (i.) Small first cost.
- (ii.) Highest class construction.
- (iii.) Low cost of maintenance.
- (iv.) Uniform time always ensured.
- (v.) No battery troubles, owing to the very small current employed.
